# MHA TEAMS UP WITH SM COUNTY HEALTH TO FIGHT COVID-19

MHA has partnered with the San Mateo County Health System to support families and individuals needing to isolate or quarantine due to testing positive for COVID-19 or having been in close contact with someone who has. The MHA Public Health Support program was quickly developed to support county residents to remove barriers to safely isolate. In the program's first few weeks, 201 households have benefited from economic relief, grocery delivery, medication support, essential supplies and referrals to other

agencies for more long-term help if needed. The program runs through December, targeting low income residents, particularly essential and front-line workers, many of whom are living in multi-generational housing. The support received through this program is allowing them to quarantine for their safety and the safety of our community. This deeper support also helps to mitigate the disparities in health care that some of our County residents experience. •













The shelter in place orders haven't stopped MHA from growing to meet critical needs in our County. Here are some of the people who have joined our team during the last few months.




